Energy Efficiency

- CERT Insulation installers can access funding to reduce the cost of insulation for any homeowner. Speak to Act on Energy for more information.
- Warm Front If you need help paying for heating and insulation improvements in your privately owned or rented home, you may be able to get money from the government's Warm Front grants scheme if, for example, you're receiving income or disability-related benefits. Contact Warm Front on 0800 316 6011.
- Redditch Borough Council has three new grants for insulation:
 - 1 Free loft and/or cavity wall insulation for over 60's
 - 2 Free loft and or cavity wall insulation for accredited private landlords' properties
 - 3 Grants for loft and/or cavity wall insulation for pre 1919 private dwellings in the Town Centre
- Council Tax Rebate scheme Contact British Gas on 0845 971 7731 and quote "REDCT". If you have your insulation installed by British Gas through this scheme you will qualify for a Council Tax rebate.

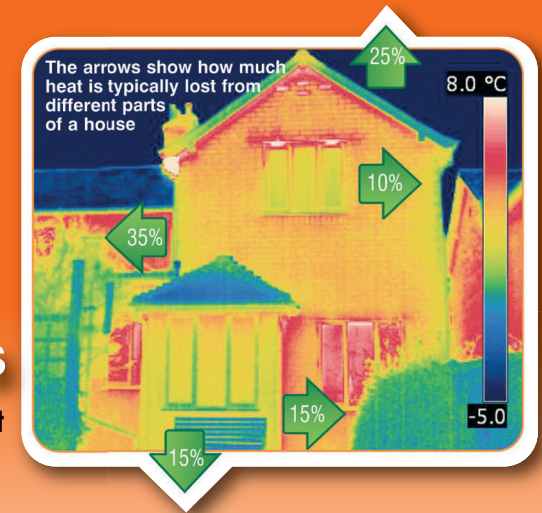
